Maintenance Guidelines

It's important to care for your rug properly to ensure its longevity and pristine appearance.

Regular vacuuming is essential to manage shedding of loose fibers that may occur, especially with a new rug. However, avoid using a vacuum cleaner with a rotating or brush head, as this could potentially damage the rug fibers.

In the event of spills, act promptly by blotting them with a clean, undyed cloth. Refrain from dry cleaning or using harsh chemicals on your rug, as these could cause damage or fading.

When not in use, never fold your rug for storage or store it in an airtight bag, as this can lead to creases or moisture buildup. Instead, store it flat or rolled with proper ventilation.

To prevent uneven wear, rotate your rug periodically, and minimize direct or continuous exposure to sunlight, as prolonged exposure can cause fading.

Occasional professional cleaning is recommended to maintain the pristine condition of your rug and prolong its lifespan.

Product Specifications

Size Variation: Please note that due to the handmade nature of our rugs, a slight size variation of up to 5% is possible. Additionally, variations in pile height and total thickness within the range of 1–3 mm are considered normal and acceptable.

Color Variations: While every effort is made to minimize color variation, it's important to acknowledge that our rugs are predominantly crafted from natural fibers, which may result in slight color differences. Over time, cut pile rugs may exhibit light and dark patches as the fibers naturally bend and reflect light differently. Our rugs are intentionally designed to showcase gentle linear variations across the background. Exposure to direct and continuous sunlight may cause fading over time, although this is not a manufacturing defect. Please be aware that the colors represented in our product images are indicative only, and for the most accurate representation, we recommend matching them to our samples before placing an order.

Rug Care Guidelines

Shedding: It's common for natural fiber rugs to shed loose fibers initially, a process that can be accelerated through regular vacuuming.

Pop-ups: Due to the weaving process, short fibers may emerge as the rug settles. These can easily be trimmed by hand using household scissors for a tidy appearance.

Underlay/Rug Pads: To enhance the performance and longevity of your rug, we highly recommend using an underlay or rug pad with all our products. This provides added cushioning, prevents slipping, and helps protect your floors.
